- ◆ Assist and educate children, parents and school staff to manage chronic diseases while at school
- ◆ Train school staff on what to do to provide immediate assistance to children in health emergencies
- ◆ Conduct health screenings for vision and hearing, scoliosis and BMI
- ◆ Teach health education classes such as growth and development, personal hygiene, hand washing, nutrition and sun safety

Community Health & Planning

- ◆ Work with community partners to gather health data and identify opportunities for improvement
- ◆ Track, record and archive health data and analysis
- ◆ Coordinate health improvement, strategic planning, accreditation and quality improvement processes within the department
- ◆ Develop community health assessments and community health improvement plans
- ◆ Provide information to media and public on health issues and interests

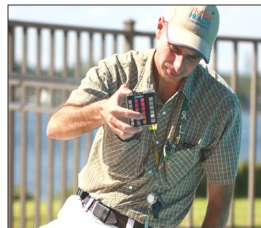
