1. Medicaid Eligibility Determination.
2. WIC Appointment.
3. Healthy Start Screen.
4. Appointment to OB Doctor.

**Please Bring These Items To Your Interview Appointment:**

1. **Pregnancy Statement** – Statement confirming you are pregnant . . . with
  - \*Estimated due date
  - \*Signed by a doctor or nurse
2. **Social Security Card** – If you don't have one, you should apply for one.
3. **Picture ID** – Drivers license, state or school I.D., or any form of picture I.D.
4. **Income Verification** –
  - \*Paycheck stubs for the past month (approximately 4 – two if paid bi-weekly).
  - \*Letter from your employer, verifying your payment amount . . . hours . . . and when you're paid (weekly, hourly, monthly).
  - \*If you are in college, a financial aid letter will help verify your income.
  - \*If you receive child support, you should bring proof.
5. **Birth Certificate**
6. **If non-citizen, please bring in Visa/Passport.**
